T-SHIRTS

Will be distributed on Sunday only in conjunction with bib pick-up at the San Gabriel Mission expoarea located near the start/ finish at Broadway and Carmelita.

IMPORTANT: T-Shirts for all same day registration is not guaranteed. Pick-up will be after the start of the race.

BIB ASSIGNMENT

Bib numbers will not be pre-assigned. Participant bibs will be assigned at packet pick-up using dynamic bib assignment. Volunteers will check-in runners and assign the bib number during this time.

PARKING

Allow plenty of time to get to the registration area and pick up your bib & t-shirt. Arrive early and factor in traffic to ensure you make it to the start line on time. We expect over 20,000 participants for the entire festival throughout the day.

Course Information

STARTING LINE

Runners are encouraged to begin lining up no later than 8:45A. The race will start on time at 9:00 am.

Line up according to your expected race pace. Faster runners should be positioned at the front of the start chute, while slower runners/walkers/strollers start on the back. The goal is to have the start flow nicely and safely. Remember you are being chip timed.

COURSE DESIGN | Historic San Gabriel Mission

M2M 5000 (5K) is flat blazing-fast course that starts near the
historic San Gabriel Mission. It is all on closed public streets
along South Santa Anita Street, Las Tunas Blvd, and Main Street.
Views of the foothills and gradual downslope to the finish.

WATER STATIONS | PRESENTED BY POCARI SWEAT
Water and Pocari Sweat (www.TryPocari.Com) electrolytes will be available
at the 1.5 mile mark and at the finish.

FIRST AID SUPPORT


We will have a roving first aid team covering the 5K route and at the open streets festival. First aid station also available at the finish line area.
